Conversely, Crops can be affected by the ensuing drenching after landfall and some imported goods in ports and warehouses can be destroyed or affected... Coffee is one of them...

Typically, Coffee is a buy on a good hard decline during September and tends to act rather well all the way into year-end....We want to re-establish our long posture... preferably on weakness Wheat tends to move higher into October as does Sugar. .

The Hog market offers some opportunities, Seasonally Buying Feb Hogs August 29th and exiting Sept 14th has made money most of the last 15 years...


However, we also want to sell rallies in pork if they get pricey before the Pig Crop


